- What is the principle involved behind the cities of refuge?

Read *Joshua 21-22*

- Summarize chapter 23.
- Why was it so important to worship the Lord at this point?

Saturday, May 22 Pray for the Special Offering tomorrow

Read *Jeremiah 17-20*

- What is significant about the phrase, "This is what the Lord says"?
- What do you do when you sense God speaking to you from His word?

Sunday, May 23 Celebration Sunday

Read *Psalms 58-60 and Proverbs 20*
