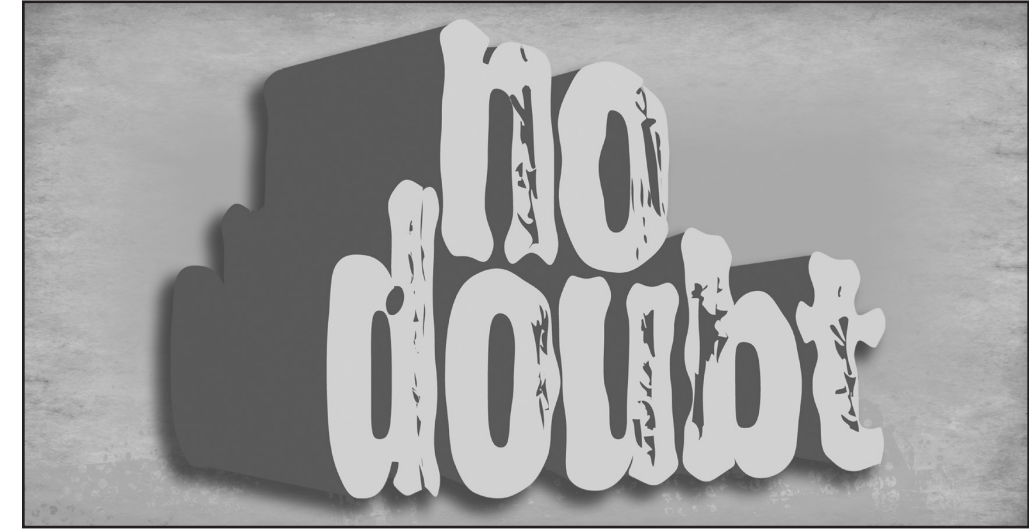
Our Featured Missionary
